2009-10 HUNTING SEASON INSTRUCTIONS, LAHWMA

Hunters **MUST** submit a copy of their driver's license, hunting license and fill out/sign a liability release before purchasing a Permit, and report **ALL** harvest information. Purchase of Permit does not guarantee the harvest of game.

DOVE and QUAIL HUNTS

Hunters may purchase permits for the above dates on a “first-come, first-served” basis. **Permits MUST be purchased by WEDNESDAY 5pm BEFORE the weekend that you plan to hunt.** Hunters must bring their driver's license (DL) to indicate residency, 2009-10 hunting license (HL) complete with stamps (migratory game bird stamp is required to hunt mourning dove, and an upland game bird stamp is required to hunt quail) and cash, check or MasterCard/Visa in order to obtain a permit and reserve space. **Hunters registering by fax must fax copies of their DL and HL with their application.** There will be no refund for permits not subsequently used, and no date substitution due to adverse weather conditions. Dove and quail bag and possession limits will conform to those established by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for Kent and Garza County. Absolutely **NO** baiting will be allowed before or during dove hunts. **NO BATTERY POWERED FEEDERS OR ROAD BAITING ALLOWED** during dove or quail hunts. Bird dogs are strongly recommended during quail hunts.

DEER HUNTS – ARCHERY AND RIFLE

Deer hunters may be included in a **RANDOM DRAWING** for the available hunts as shown. An archery stamp on your HL is required. **Hunting parties must sign up together; specify deer hunt of your selection-one entry per person or hunting party ONLY, per hunt.** Drawing for the archery hunts will take place on September 4th; winners will be notified by phone or email. Archery permits must be purchased by September 18th to reserve your space. Cancellations after Sept 30 will result in loss of any paid fees. Drawing for the rifle hunts will take place on October 9th. Rifle hunt permits must be purchased by October 23rd to reserve your space. Late cancellations will result in loss of any paid fees. White tail doe (antlerless) hunters may take no more than 2 (two) does per hunter. Hunters may also take feral hog during their deer hunt, for no extra charge. There will be no refund of permits not subsequently used, and no date substitutions due to adverse weather conditions. Hunters may use their own tree stand or blind, and bring bait of their selection. Hunters must remove blinds/stands from City property immediately after their hunt is ended. **NO BATTERY POWERED FEEDERS OR ROAD BAITING ALLOWED.** Youth doe hunts arranged by sponsoring agencies (Texas Wildlife Association and National Rifle Association) are free of charge to all participants. TURKEY HUNTS

Spring gobbler turkey hunts are available by **RANDOM DRAWING.** **Hunting parties must sign up together; specify the hunt date of your choice – one entry per person or hunting party ONLY, per hunt.** Drawing for the turkey hunts will take place on March 12th. Permits must be purchased by March 19th to reserve your space. Cancellation after March 26th will result in the loss of any paid fees. There will be no refund of permits not subsequently used, and no date substitutions due to adverse weather conditions. Turkey hunt parties will be assigned a specific area from which they may harvest their turkeys. An upland game bird stamp is required to hunt turkeys.

FERAL HOG HUNTS

Permits **MUST** be purchased by Wednesday 5 pm before the weekend that you plan to hunt; **hunters will be assigned to specific hunt areas.**
